English

We will focus on applying phonics to write words and structure sentences. We will also learn about noun phrases and how to use these to add detail to our work.

Mathematics

Throughout this term we will focus on counting, reading and writing numbers, number order and place value. We will also cover addition, subtraction and shape.

Science

We will be investigating materials and their properties. At home you could talk about what different items are made from and why. We will look at the suitability of materials and how some can be changed too.

PSHE

We will be exploring what a team is and how to work well as a team.

Computing

The children will learn about internet safety and digital photography.

ART & DT

Art will be about collecting natural items and drawing them in our sketchbooks. DT is about structures. We will look at making them strong and different bases.

RE

We will be learning about respect, creation and giving thanks

History is about nurturing nurses from the past (including Florence Nightingale) and Geography is all about where we live. This will include the countries of the UK and continents of the world.
