We want to make you aware of a recent issue affecting some popular children's books by Andrew Cope, including the Spy Dogs, Spy

Cats, and Spy Pups series.



Some editions of these books include a printed web address at the back. This link used to go to the author's website, but the domain is no longer under his control. It has since been taken over by another party and now leads to inappropriate adult content.

The publisher, Puffin, has paused sales and distribution of the books and is working with schools, libraries, and retailers to remove copies from circulation. They have stressed that the website has no connection to the author or publisher. We have checked all our class libraries—so can you please also check at home.
