Clubs—Autumn term 2

The new clubs online forms for next half term have been sent out today. The after school coach clubs are the same as this half term—so please book early if your child wishes to continue as some clubs were

full guickly. Clubs include: football skills for KS1 and KS2 with Mr Parton; Lego club; Musical Theatre with Tophat; STEM science club with crazy experiments with Mr Meredith; Art club for KS1 and a fantastic High 5 netball club with Mrs Jordan. Chill club bookings are also on a separate booking form. If you know your requirements for next half term then please do book them on. It helps us enormously if bookings are set but not changed, as it is a huge administrative job to set it all up.

### COVID update—high cases in Telford

Cases in children aged 4-14 are rising quickly. Some schools are having to introduce a range of measures as cases spread quickly.

It is clear that Lateral Flow tests are not effective on younger children because the viral load is often too low to pick up on these tests. If your child has any symptoms-then they must have a PCR test as this has a higher level of sensitivity. If you are not sure about your child's symptoms, then test as a precaution. Most children show very mild symptoms, if any.
