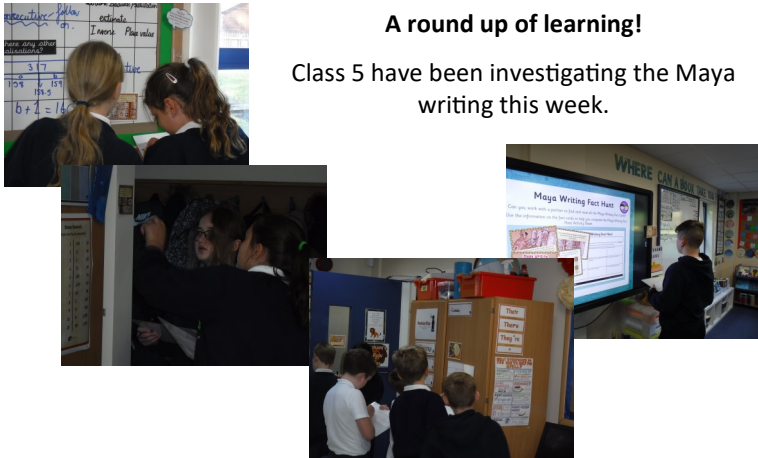
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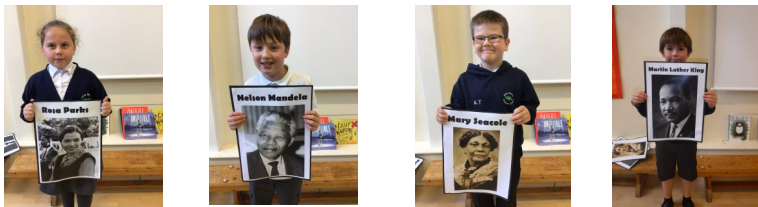


A round up of learning!

COVID update—positive case in school

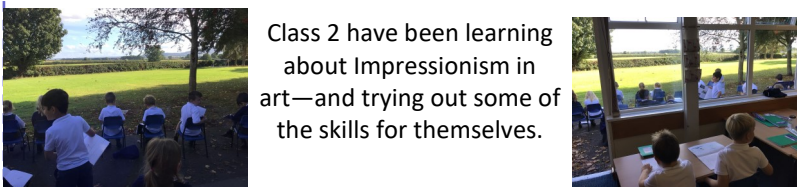
Please note that some families have been contacted via email today with regards to a positive case in school. We have done very well to get to this point in the term without a case.
