COVID-19—Information Update

Changes to guidance from Monday 17th:

- If your child has tested positive for COVID, then on day 5 and 6 you should test with a Lateral Flow test. If both these consecutive tests are negative then they can return to school on Day 6. This would mean tests must be completed early mornings on those days. If the tests return positive, then your child can only return early if they have 2 consecutive negative tests. From Day 11, your child should return to school provided that they do not still have a temperature.
- From 11th January, if your child tests positive on a LF test, then a confirmatory PCR is not required. Anyone will a positive LF test will need to isolate immediately. This is a national temporary suspension. You should be using LF tests with your child if a household member has tested positive.
- All remote learning will be on the website if your child is isolating. We will contact you on Day 1.
- From next week the expectation is that when there is one case in a class, please LF test your child for 7 days. As of today we have 5 cases in total: Classes 1, 3, 4, and 5.

Each week the children earn raffle tickets or 'Dojo points' as they demonstrate the 5Rs in their learning and friendships. A child from each class is chosen for a certificate.


