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A trip to Cosford

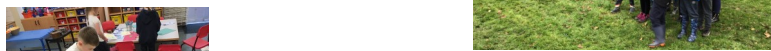
As part of the History theme about flight, Class 2 had fun at Cosford yesterday. Lots of dressing up and finding out about planes!
