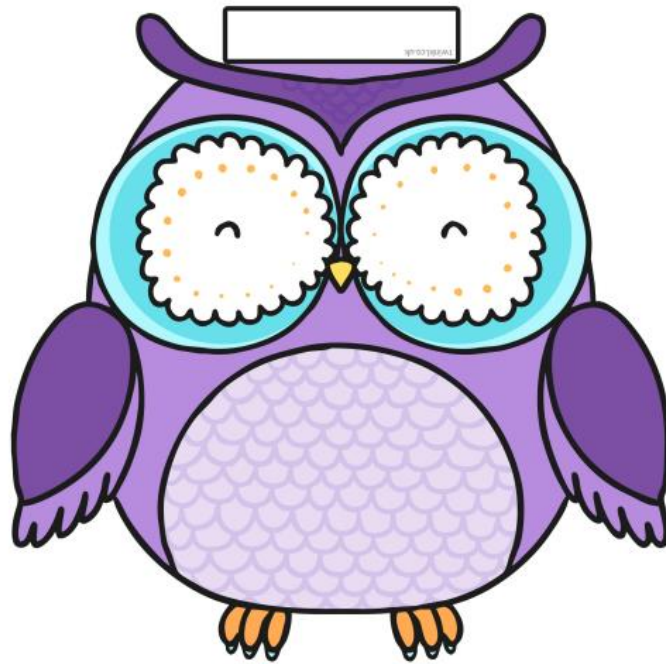


Welcome to Class 3



Key information

- PE is on Monday and Outdoor Learning is on Friday.

Homework



- Homework is set every Friday and must be done by Friday.
- The children have Maths and Spelling Shed homework each week. Multiple practices on Spelling Shed will help with weekly spelling tests
- Children should go on TTRS at least once a week.
- Children's passwords are in the front of their reading journals.
- Reading journals are to be handed in on a Friday, please try to read 5 times a week. Children can read to an adult, other family member or to themselves. Please can an adult sign the journals each week.



English

We will be focusing on writing to inform and writing to entertain. Daily guided reading sessions will focus on reading comprehension and the language features of fiction, non-fiction texts and poetry.

Our class reader for the first half term is 'Stig of the Dump' by Clive King. In the second half term we will be reading 'The Sheep Pig' by Dick King Smith.

French

In C3 we will be learning how to greet people, the names of colours, days, weeks and months.

Computing

The children will learn about how to keep safe online for the first half term, and then learn some basic computer skills through looking at Microsoft Word.

Mathematics

This term we will be learning about place value, addition and subtraction, and multiplication and division.

History & Geography

This term, Class 3 will be learning about The Stone Age.

In Geography we will learn land use and farming.

RE

Our RE lessons will explore and compare creation stories.

Science

In the first half of the term Year 3 will be focusing on Light while Year 4 study States of Matter. In the second half term, Year 3 will learn about Forces and Magnets and Year 4 will learn about electricity.

Art & DT

In DT we are learning to prepare savoury food, with a focus on bread.

In Art our theme is gestural drawing with charcoal.

Music

In C3 a music teacher will come into school once a week to teach us to play the ukulele.

Our theme this term is 'Be Yourself'
