We hope that you have had a lovely Christmas break and managed some relaxing family time too.

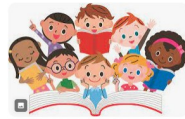
It's lovely to see all the children back this week—ready to start the Spring term and enjoy all the new learning planned.
