Bingo: A flyer and information came home this week—Thursday 13th June at 5.30pm. Please come along and bring the family, including grandparents and older siblings!

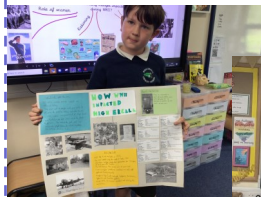
Entrance is free, and £1 per bingo card. There will be drinks and snacks on sale.
